1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 2021-2021 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US SAILING, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 This regatta will be open to the O'pen Skiff divisions:

U12 – Must not be turning 12 in the calendar year

U15 – Must not be turning 15 in the calendar year

Open – Must be 15+ years in the calendar year and under 23 years old on the day of the regatta

2.2 Participants must be current members of Hawaii Youth Sailing Association (HYSA) and under 23 years old on the day of the regatta.

2.3 Entry fee will be \$10 for all youth members.

4. CHANGES IN THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change in the sailing instructions will be posted before 10:00 AM on the KYC bulletin board

Subsequent races immediately following. Five races will be attempted.

No race will start after 4:00 pm

Awards to follow racing.

6. SCORING

The race will be scored according to the low point scoring system, appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing. Each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, discarding her worst score if, five (5) or more races are completed.

7. NUMBER OF RACES

Five (5) races will be attempted but the regatta will be scored based on the number of races completed within the allotted time.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted at the skipper's meeting.

9. ALTERATIONS IN RACING RULES

Rule (61.1 a) has been modified in that a flag is not required to lodge protest.

10. COURSE

The courses to be sailed will be hailed from the race committee boat before each race.

11. PROTESTS

Protests must be filed within one half hour after the race committee boat docks.

12. AWARDS

The top three boats in each class will receive awards: O'pen Skiff (BIC) U12, U15, Open

**** Note** that HYSA will now be using the International Fleet Classification of U12, U15, Open, which is a change from the previous divisions of "A and B".
